Prof. Dr. Parsudi Suparlan

Prof. Dr. Parsudi Suparlan is an expert in Urban Anthropology, Urban poverty and multiculturalism. He was born in Jakarta on April 3, 1938. He finished his Bachelor program in Anthropology at Faculty of Letters UI in 1964. In 1970, he pursued an opportunity to study at University of Illinois, United States, and gained his MA degree in 1972 and also Ph.D in Anthropology in 1976. In 1961, he became the assistant of Prof. Harsya W. Bahtiar in Faculty of Letters UI and became a permanent lecturer since 1963. He's still teaching in S1, S2, S3 program, Department of Anthropology, FISIP UI; in PTIK (Police Academy), S2 and S3 Program, in Police Science major, UI; S2 program for American Studies UI and has become the Head of the Department of American Studies since 1998. Most of his works have been published (more than 200 works since 1964). Some of them are *The Javanese Suriname: Ethnicity in Ethnically Plural Society* (Arizona State University, 1995). *Sakai People in Riau: Alienated People in Indonesian Society* (Yayasan Obor 1995), and *Intertribal Relations, Urban Society and Culture*, published by YPKIK, 2004. In 1999, Parsudi Suparlan created Indonesian Police Journal and has become the Editor in Chief since then.
